...NEXT STOP IS VIETNAM: The War On Record, 1961 – 2008 ist eine faszinierende, jahrelang detailliert vorbereitete Anthologie über das musikalische Erbe des Vietnamkriegs. Die Sammlung – mit 13 CDs und einem über 300-seitigem Buch voller seltener Archiv-Fotos – dokumentiert den Krieg auf intensive und nie zuvor gezeigte Art und Weise. Mehr als 330 Titel (gesungen und gesprochen) nehmen den Hörer mit auf eine Reise durch eine epochale Phase der jüngeren Zeitgeschichte. Von Amerikas ersten, naiven Vorstellungen eines Landes namens Vietnam über musikalisch geführte Diskussionen zum Thema Krieg und seine Moral bis hin zur Verarbeitung der langen Nachwirkungen des Konflikts – diese Sammlung deckt all das und noch viel mehr ab. Bob Dylan, Joan Baez, Merle Haggard, Pete Seeger, Bruce Springsteen, Phil Ochs, Johnny Cash, Yoko Ono, John Lennon, The Doors, Country Joe McDonald und Dutzende anderer Interpreten (darunter viele Vietnam-Veteranen) begleiten authentisch diese aufklärende und gleichermaßen unterhaltende Reise.

Das farbige, die Musik informierend begleitende Buch ist gespickt mit Informationen des Musikwissenschaftlers Hugo A. Keesing zu den Songs und den Künstlern, die sie aufgenommen haben; die Geschichte des Krieges erzählt die Vietnam-Historikerin Lois T. Vietri; die Autoren Doug Bradley und Craig Werner schreiben über die Lieblingssongs der Soldaten im Feld. Das Vorwort zu diesem imposanten Werk stammt vom legendären Country Joe McDonald.
